#### 378 CONSIDERATION OF THE BUDGET 2018 - 2019

The budget had been deliberated at Full Council on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2017 and the Finance Committee on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2017 when proposals had been considered. A final draft budget had then been circulated in preparation for discussion and amendment.

At the budget setting meeting the final draft was scrutinized and adjustments made.

It was **RESOLVED** that the Estates Officer position be reduced to 20 hours per week.

**Community Halls** – 2 alternative funding options were put forward

- 1. One sum of  $\pounds7500$  to be allocated jointly to the community halls. Either hall could request financial assistance from this amount.
- 2. £5000 to be allocated for the Gwenllian Centre: £2500 to Mynydd y Garreg Hall.
